Annual E-Scow Open Regatta

June 5th, 6th, and 7th, 2009

Syracuse, Indiana

Venue

The 2009 Wawasee Regatta racing will take place on beautiful Lake Wawasee in Northern Indiana. The Yacht Club is located at 6338 E. Trusdell Ave., Syracuse, IN 46567.

Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* and Scantlings of the National Class E Scow Association. Competitors may use different numbers of crew (drop/add) during the series.

Eligibility

The regatta is open to all E-Scows defined by the NCESA including both asymmetrical and symmetrical spinnaker designs. Skippers must be regular members of the NCESA. If you're not already a member, please join in advance.

Registration

Registration will be held at the Wawasee Yacht Club on Friday from 6pm to 9pm, and Saturday from 8am to 9:30am. No preregistration is necessary; however we would appreciate notification of your attendance via email or phone call.

Courses

Racing will be windward-leeward courses with the option of a downwind finish. There will be a maximum of 5 races to be sailed.

Schedule of Events (Eastern Daylight Savings Time)

Friday- 5pm practice races.

Saturday- 9:30am Competitors meeting. 10:30am Race One Start, 3 Races, Dinner party.

Sunday- 10am Start, No Race to begin after 1pm. Awards!

Scoring

The low point system, Appendix A2 of *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, will be used. There will be no throw-outs and one point will be awarded for first. Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

Fees

\$95 includes appetizers on Friday night and beverages all weekend. Continental breakfasts will also be included, with lunches available for purchase. The Dinner party Saturday night will be at the Yacht Club (price to be determined).

Awards

The Top five places for skipper and crew in the gold fleet, and the Top two places for skipper and crew in the silver fleet. *Voluntary fleet designation at time of registration.*
