**Eligibility & Rules** - Regular membership in the National Class E-Scow Sailing Association is required. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, Scantlings of NCESA, and the prescriptions and sailing instructions of US Sailing.

**Racing** - There will be two fleets, Gold and Silver. Entry in either fleet is by competitor's choice. Five (5) races are scheduled.

**Courses** - Racing will be windward-leeward courses with the option of a downwind finish. There will be a maximum of 5 races to be sailed.

**Scoring** - The low point system, Appendix A2 of The Racing Rules of Sailing, will be used. There will be no throw-outs and one point will be awarded for first. Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.
