ESCOW FALL REGATTA Delavan Lake Yacht Club September 5-7 2008

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

Except as any of the following are altered or inconsistent with this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the scantling rules of the National Class E Scow Association (NCESA), and NCESA By-laws Article VI, and Article VIII, parts 4 and 5, with the exception that any of the NCESA scantling rules (including, but not limited to, III.4, VI. 4 and VII.4).

2. BOATING REGULATIONS

The boating regulations of the State of Wisconsin will apply.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to E Scows with asymmetrical and symmetrical spinnaker rigging. All E Scows, regardless of spinnaker type, will sail and be scored together.

4. REGISTRATION FEE

4.1 Regatta Entry Fee: \$35.

4.2 Registration will take place at Regatta Headquarters.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Friday, September 5, 2008

- a. Registration from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. (Competitors are invited to set up the boat and practice any time prior to registration)

Saturday, September 6, 2008

- a. Registration from 7:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.
- b. Competitor's Briefing at 9:15 a.m.
- c. Warning Signal for Race #1 at 10:30 a.m.
- d. Lunch after Race #1, Lunch will be available for purchase from the Club's regular kitchen menu.
- e. Next race: The regatta is scheduled to have five races. Except when races are sailed back-to-back, the time of the Warning Signal for Race Nos. 2 - 5 will be posted. No race will begin after Noon on Sunday, September 7, 2008.
- f. Saturday evening the club will be hosting a fish fry dinner available for purchase at time of dinner.

Sunday, September 7, 2008

- a. Racing will begin as posted.
- b. Trophy presentation will be held approximately one hour after completion of racing for the day.
- c. Lunch will be available for purchase from the Club's regular kitchen menu.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

7. REGATTA HEADQUARTERS

The Regatta Headquarters will be Delavan Lake Yacht Club, Delavan, Wisconsin.

8. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions. The racing area will be on Delavan Lake and will be described at the Competitor's Briefing or by notice on the Official Notice Board at the Regatta Headquarters.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

10. SCORING

Scoring will be U.S. Sailing Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A4. One race will constitute a regatta.

11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

The Race Committee will use VHF marine radio to communicate to the competitors. The only communication devices that may be used by competitors when racing are: (a) a weather monitor, (b) a VHF radio tuned to receive only Race Committee transmissions that are intended for all boats (competitor channel) and (c) a cell phone that may be used for emergency purposes only. The penalty for breaking this rule will be total disqualification from the regatta or such lesser penalty as may be determined by the Protest Committee. Failure to hear a Race Committee transmission shall not constitute grounds for redress. Except to make a required report or in an emergency, no transmission shall be made to the Race Committee or other person when racing.

12. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to the top five yachts based on the overall standings of all yachts.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
