Regatta Venue

The Wawasee Yacht Club - 6338 E. Trusdell Ave., Syracuse, In 46567 - will host the 25th annual E Scow Open Regatta. The racing will take place on Lake Wawasee in Syracuse, Indiana.

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and scantlings of the National Class E Scow Association. Competitors may use different numbers of crew (drop and add) during the series.

Eligibility

This regatta is open to all E Scows as defined in the scantlings that have registered for the event. Skippers must be regular members of the NCESA. *(Please join in advance!)*

Registration

Registration will be held on the porch of the WYC on Friday from 6:00pm to 9:00pm and Saturday from 8:00am to 9:30am. While no preregistration is necessary, we would appreciate notification of your potential attendance via email or phone call.

Equipment

VHF radio will be used to communicate to the competitors. Floatation panels may be required during racing at the discretion of the PRO.

Courses

Courses will be Windward Leeward with the option of a downwind finish.

Number of Races

There are a maximum of five races to be sailed.

Scoring

The low point system, Appendix A2 of The Racing Rules of Sailing, will be used. There will be no throw outs.

Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at registration.

Awards

Top five places for skipper and crew in gold fleet.

Top two places for skipper and crew in silver fleet.

Voluntary fleet designation at time of registration.

Fees

\$95 includes cocktail party on Friday night, lunches for three on both days, continental breakfast, lots of beverages and awards. There will be a dinner party on Saturday evening (with price to be determined) and additional lunches available for purchase.
